Subject.- Advertisement Notice for the post of Constable Executive, Armed/IRP, HG/CD/SDRF in Ladakh Police.

Online applications are invited from eligible Residents of Union territory of Ladakh for the post of Constable Executive, Armed/IRP, HG/CD/SDRF in Ladakh Police against (213) vacancies in the Pay Level-2 (19900-63200).

The detailed terms and conditions with regards to eligibility, educational qualification, age, physical standards, desired qualifications, mode of recruitment, reservation, quota in recruitment etc are as follows.-

1. **Essential Qualifications:-** The essential educational qualification, age and physical standard prescribed for the above mentioned post are specified as under.-

i.	Essential Educational Qualification.	The candidate should have passed 10 th examination from a recognized Board of School Education before the last date for submission of application form. (8 th passed form a recognized school for any serving Special Police Officer (SPO) with a continous period of engagement of minimum three years).
ii.	Age (As on January 1st 2021.	a. The candidates should not be below 18 years and above 28 years in age. (the candidates born beofre 01-01-1993 and after 31-12-2002 shall not be eligible). b. In case of serving Special Police Officer (SPO) and Voluntary Home Guard

		(VHG) with a continuous period of engagement of three years and five years respectively, the upper age limit shall be 37 years. c. The upper age limit for Ex-Serviceman shall be 48 years.
iii.	Physical Standards	Height,- a. Male.- Minimum 162 cms. b. Female.- Minimum 152 cms. Chest.- (Male only) Un-expanded.- Minimum 81 cms. Expanded.- Minimum 85 cms.

2. Desired qualifications:

- i. Proficiency in driving and possession of Light Motor Vehicle Driving License with (TRANS).
- ii. One year certificate course in Computer Application from an AICTE recognized institution.

5% of the maximum marks of the examination shall be awarded, to candidates possessing any of the above desired qualifications, based on desired qualification test.

A candidate can claim incentives (marks) for only one of the above desired qualification.

3. **Incentives to National Cadet Corps (NCC) certificate holders:-** the Incentives to National Cadet Corps (NCC) certificate holders shall be granted at the following scales:-

- I. **Physical measurement test:-** Standards of Physical measurement shall be as provided in schedule-II(A) of the Ladakh Police (subordinate) Service Recruitment Rules 2021, reproduced below for ready reference:-

Height male = minimum 162 cms

Height female = minimum 152 cms

Chest (only for male candidates):-

Unexpended = minimum 81 cms

Expended = minimum 85 cms.

Note-1: candidates who don't qualify the physical measurement test shall be disqualified and shall not be allowed to participate in the remaining recruitment process.

- II. **Physical endurance test:- (50 Marks)**

Physical endurance test shall be taken only of those candidates who qualify the physical measurement tests. The physical endurance shall be of maximum 50 marks and shall consists of the following activities:

a. Long race (1600 meters for male: 1000 meters for female). 25 marks

b. Short sprint (100 meters) 25 marks

The candidates shall be allocated marks for the above activates based on their performance. The performance based marks allocated and disqualification cutoff shall be as tabulated below:

Note 1:- Candidates shall qualify both the tests separately.

Note 2:- Only Candidates who qualify the long race shall be eligible for Short Sprint.

- III. **Scrutiny of original documents / testimonials:-** Candidates who qualify the physical endurance test shall submit their original documents / testimonials, along with self attested photo copies of the documents/testimonials, for scrutiny. (The scrutiny is provisional and all documents / testimonials shall be subjected to verification through concerned authority).
- IV. **Desired qualification test:** - The test shall be conducted only for those candidates who's documents / testimonials have been scrutinized and claimed in their application that they possess one of the below desired qualification:
- Proficiency in driving and possession of Light Motor Vehicle Driving License with TRANS.
 - One year certificate course in Computer Application from an AICTE recognized institution.

For candidates possessing desired qualification (i) above driving test shall be conducted. The driving test shall be conducted as per the latest driving test guideline formulated by the relevant department in the UT Administration.

For candidates possessing desired qualification (ii) above written test and/or practical exam shall be conducted.

- V. **Written examination (objective type):-** All candidates who have qualified the physical measurement test and who's documents / testimonials have been scrutinized and found correct shall be put through a written examination which shall be of 80 minutes duration. The written exam will consist of one objective type paper containing 100 questions and each question carrying 01 mark. There will be no negative marking for wrong answer. The question paper for written exam will be in English only. The question paper shall be of matriculation level. The syllabus for the examination is as follows.

5. **Reservation.-** The reservation under this Advertisement Notification shall be applicable in accordance with the provisions of the Union territory of Ladakh Reservation Rules amended vide SO 14 dated 23rd April 2020.
6. **Quota.-** Quota for Outstanding Sports Person, Special Police Officer (SPO) and Voluntary Home Guard (VHG) shall be applicable in accordance with the provisions of the Ladakh Police (Subordinate) Service Recruitment Rules, 2021.
7. The last date for submission of online application form shall be 30 days from the date of activation of the link. The date of activation of the link, fee applicable and the instructions for filling the online application form will be notified separately.
8. The number of vacancies notified is tentative.
9. The selected candidates shall be required to undergo the Basic Recruitment Training Course.
10. The recruitment shall be subject to the provisions of Ladakh Police (Subordinate) Service Recruitment Rules, 2021 and any Standing Order issued under the provisions of the said Rules.
11. The candidates shall have to appear in the prescribed tests at their own expense on the date and venue to be notified by the Ladakh Police (Subordinate) Service Recruitment Board.
